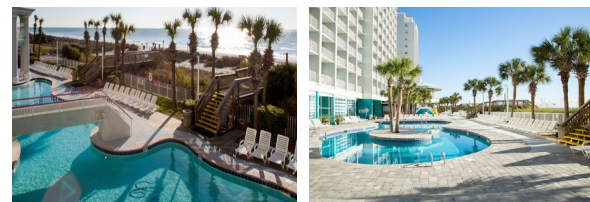
Wed. Sept. 15 Myrtle Beach
