DAY 1, THURSDAY, DECEMBER 1, 2022 - DEPART PHILADELPHIA, USA

DAY 3, SATURDAY, DECEMBER 3, 2022 - HALF-DAY SIGHTSEEING TOUR OF LONDON & AFTERNOON AT LEISURE

This morning you will enjoy a tour visiting two of the most impressive monuments within London's original "Square Mile". Visit the Tower of London, a former fortress and Royal Palace that has witnessed 1000 years of history most notoriously as a prison. Now the Crown Jewels are kept here and you will have a viewing of these, as well as seeing the iconic Tower Bridge. In the afternoon you are at leisure. Perhaps you might like to visit Portobello Road Market which only takes place on Saturday and Sunday. This street, in the Notting Hill section of London, is closed to traffic and becomes a vibrant street market selling everything from antiques to food and fashion, household goods, vintage clothing, collectible, bric-a-brac, furniture, and probably even the proverbial kitchen sink. Street entertainers add to the lively atmosphere of this spirited event. You can certainly find souvenirs here for family and friends back home. Alternatively, you can continue to explore London's worldclass museums or take an interesting walking tour. Seat Assignments

Seats will be requested per your completed passport name list and confirmed no earlier than 40 days prior to departure. Every airline has different group seating policies. Any name change may result in that seat being revoked by the carrier. Bulkhead and exit row seats are considered at airport check-in only. Domestic flights are blocked for group seat requests. Seats are always a request and never a guarantee. Your final seating will be determined by the airlines.

Currency Fluctuation

All prices are based on the rates of exchange in effect at the time of price quotation. In the event that the US dollar devalues, Gate 1 reserves the right to increase prices accordingly. Your final invoice(s) for tour participants will reflect increases resulting from currency devaluation.

Group Harmony

Luggage
