

MYRTLE BEACH ESCAPE

August 23-27, 2027



Day 1: Monday, August 23 (D)

Today will be a travel day. Rest stops and a lunch stop will be made along the way “on your own”. We will arrive and check-in at our hotel. Dinner will be included this evening with a buffet meal at Grande Shores Ocean Resort. You can enjoy the rest of the evening at your leisure.

Day 2: Tuesday, August 24 (B, L, D)

Enjoy a buffet breakfast at the Shoreline Cafe this morning before leaving for Murrell’s Inlet. Sit back and relax as you take in the exhilarating performance of traditional hula, powerful haka dances, and thrilling fire spinning - all set against the backdrop of the ocean breeze and swaying palms.
